

Important Announcements to the Shortlisted Candidates for Interviews for Admissions 2020

We thank the short-listed candidates for agreeing to be interviewed over internet and appreciate that this may be one of the first such experiences for you. This is to reassure you that we are working hard to make it a smooth and pleasant experience.

Most importantly, please note that candidates can always call or email the helpdesk at JNCASR in case they have a problem in internet connectivity (e.g. due to cyclonic weather or so) during the interview process. The interview committee will be most understanding and accommodating of this and acting in the best interest of students with weaker connectivity. In case the interview does not get through smoothly due to technical glitch in connectivity or so, the interview will be rescheduled and intimated. We would like you to be available on phone or email and internet so that we can be in touch with you on the day of the interview. In case the online interview process is not successful, and there is a genuine case of an in-person interview, we will consider it. However, scheduling of in-person interviews is uncertain and may take place later in the year when the COVID-19 pandemic eases out.

The process of online interviews has significant merits. For example, it allows us to engage with students constrained at home due to lock-down and almost certainly available for interviews, leading to selection for admission. It avoids the risks of contracting infections during travels, and associated costs and conflicts. Most pandemic forecasts of peaks in the COVID cases in July make in-person interviews possible only later in the year. Further, early completion of the selection procedure will give you wider choices of institutions, as the actual process of admissions are likely to occur only during August 1-31, 2020.
